A 17-Year MassMutual Vet Succeeds a 37-Year Pentegra Vet

A 37-year **Pentegra** veteran is passing the reins to a 17-year **MassMutual** veteran.

Eric Wietsma, the new president and CEO of **Pentegra**, confirmed yesterday that **Kevin Finnegan** is joining the firm as senior vice president, general counsel of the White Plains, New York-based firm. Finnegan reports to Wietsma and succeeds **Robert Alin**, who retired from the firm last week.

Finnegan, himself a Pentegra alumnus, most recently served as senior vice president and deputy general counsel at MassMutual. A MassMutual spokesperson confirmed that Finnegan has moved on.

Wietsma thanks Alin "for his many significant contributions to the Pentegra organization" and describes Finnegan as "a natual addition" to Pentegra's team.

"He is a proven leader in the retirement industry and will be a valued partner to me and to our executive team," Wietsma states. "His expertise will strengthen Pentegra as we continue to expand our fiduciary footprint and will be instrumental in advancing our business priorities."

Finnegan joined MassMutual back in 2005 after an earlier, nineyear stint at Pentegra. He also worked at MetLife. He is an alumnus of the NYU School of Law and the Quinnipiac University School of Law.

Alin joined Pentegra in 1986 and served as a professor at Adelphi University. He is an alumnus of the NYU School of Law and of the University of Rochester.
